The founding of The Holy Trinity Church predates the Constitution of California, California statehood, the birth of the Diocese of California, the

Civil War, and the settling of the West in the 19th Century. There are four church buildings that Trinity parish has called home.

Construction on the current building was completed in 1894, twelve years before most of the rest of San Francisco was leveled by the deadliest earthquake in the history of the United States. Trinity Church stood firm throughout the destruction of the old era in 1906 and the birth of the modern era thereafter. We are blessed with a storied past, a grand building of treasures, and a congregation that remains stalwart and grateful. Much like the building that is our spiritual home, the congregation of Trinity Church has withstood tremors of many kinds, but each new challenge has left us stronger to face the next.

Now, joined with St. Peter's historic and courageous congregation, we give thanks to God for having safely guided us to the point at which is centered this celebration of our past and of all that is yet to come.
